The Leilani Thomas Memorial Scholarship is available to high school seniors who reside in one of our 17 Kansas I-70 Association communities as listed to the left.

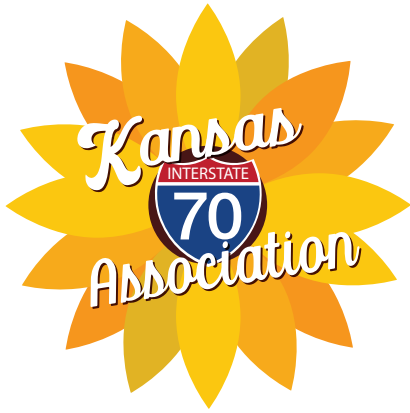

The school in which they are attending must be within the state of Kansas. The school must submit verification of enrollment and a declared major. The student is responsible for ensuring this verification is submitted. Kansas I-70 Association will pay \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester in the second year of the student's enrollment.
